The USDA made it possible for school nutrition programs to serve all students free breakfast and lunch during school year 2020-2021 and school year 2021-2022 through “waivers”.

Congress did **not** extend these waivers for the upcoming school year 2022-2023. So, the District must go back to regularly priced meals starting the first day of school, August 4, 2022.

Some schools in our district are part of a four (4) year program called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) program. This program began before the COVID-19 pandemic and is still in session.
